

Unit 1: Look At Me



This unit introduces concepts and language used in and around the home. The animated story, " Look at Me!" enables children to see and hear Lindy Loo name parts of her body and demonstrate simple actions. The other nine learning objects consolidate the unit words and concepts with simple engaging activities whilst building children’s technology skills.

Objectives

- Identify and name parts of the body and face, articles of clothing, household objects – inside and outside of the home.
- Identify the five senses and words used to describe these.
- Identify action verbs such as jump, skip, run etc.
- Enable development of computer skills such as mouse control, drag and drop, selecting icons and navigating between objects.
- To develop and extend written and spoken vocabulary of words associated with ourselves and our homes.
